Note on the 2013 ISSP Module Survey conducted in South Korea

The 2013 ISSP module survey was conducted, as usual, as an integral part of the Korean General Social Survey (KGSS). The KGSS is a nationally represented annual social survey, which usually incorporates at least two topical modules in addition to its replicating core questionnaires. Included in the 2013 KGSS, besides ISSP, are the special topical modules <Social Risks in Korea>, <Internet Usages in Korea>, and <Job Attainment in Korea>. The ISSP standard background variables are incorporated into the replicating core questionnaires section of the 2013 KGSS. In the 2013 KGSS, all ISSP variables (both topical and background) were included.
